

How to take Good Hoof Photos



Choosing the best model, selecting the correct size and correctly adjusting the horseshoe to the hoof are crucial factors for the advantages of the Duplo Horseshoe to take effect on the hoof. We regularly receive e-mails with requests for help in these areas. It is always difficult to judge the hoof situation from a distance – but without expressive photos, it is almost impossible!

Unfortunately, we often receive hoof photos with which we can't really work because the horse is placed in grass, mud or sand, or because the hooves are dirty, or because the resolution of the photos is bad, or because the perspectives are unfavorable... The quality of your photos decides how realistically we get an idea of your horse's hoof.

That's why we would like you to send us corresponding photos with every inquiry and to complete the complaint form (page 2).

When taking photos, the hoof should...

- ... be sufficiently illuminated (daylight is ideal)
- ... be clean
- ... be placed on a solid and flat surface (pavement or tarmac are ideal)
- ... be photographed with a good camera or camera phone
- ... be photographed from the right perspective
